**OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES**

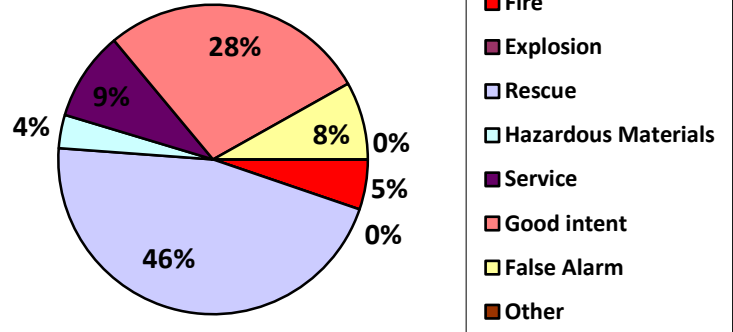
**Incidents**

There were 93 emergency fire responses during February (213 YTD). Included were the following: 3 structure fires, 0 vehicle fires, 0 equipment fires and 6 rubbish/natural cover fires.

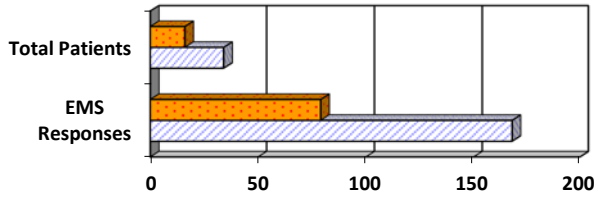
There were 187 (388 YTD) Southern Platte vehicle on scene responses during February.

Estimated fire loss during February was \$233,000.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in February was met with 79.7% effectiveness.
