OPERATIONAL ACTIVITIES

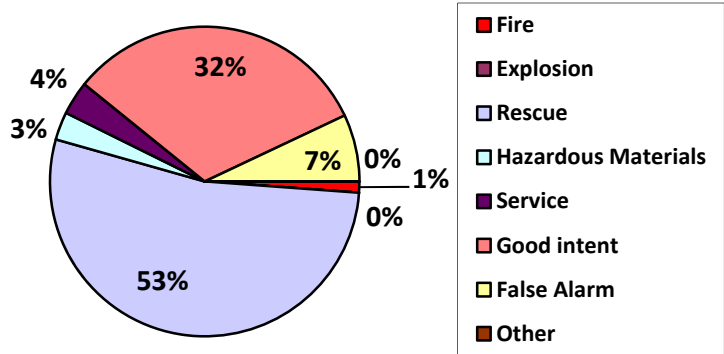
Incidents

There were 80 emergency fire responses during January (80 YTD). Included were the following: 1 structure fire, 0 vehicle fires, 0 equipment fires and 1 rubbish/natural cover fires.

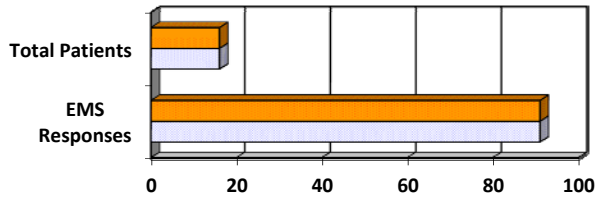
There were 147 (147 YTD) Southern Platte vehicle onscene responses during January.

Estimated fire loss during January was \$70,000.

The District's 7-minute response goal for fire calls in January was met with 86.7% effectiveness.
